Call for Abstracts (deadline: 23rd October)

‘Climate Change: Science and Society’ is a free online symposium organised by GW4 early career researchers and designed to facilitate networking between researchers working across different disciplines with an interest in climate change.

The symposium aims to bring together postgraduate researchers, early career researchers, and more established researchers to discuss the many challenges spanning a wide range of disciplines that are associated with global climate change. Participants will have the opportunity to present their work, receive feedback, and participate in relevant discussions in an interdisciplinary, accessible, and engaging environment.

We call for abstracts (300 words max) on any of the themes of the symposium:

- Impacts of climate change
- Mobilising societal change
- Sustainable solutions

If your work addresses any of our key topics, namely cities, energy, transport, food, and health, consider joining us for two afternoons packed with short talks, panel discussions with invited speakers, as well as posters on these themes.

We particularly encourage participation by scholars who identify as Black, Asian or an Ethnic minority, who are often marginalized in debates about climate change.

We will be awarding prizes for the three best posters!

We will make donations on behalf of the winners to charities of their choice, and provide them with a badge and certificate accordingly.
